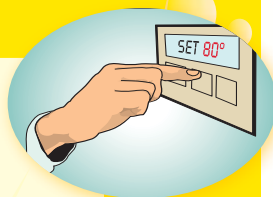


6 Simple Steps to Energy Efficiency

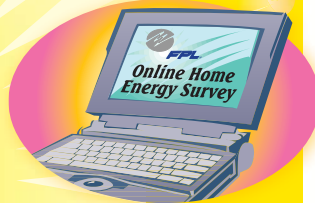
2. Use Efficient Lighting

Turn it off. Whether it's turning off lights, ceiling fans or shutting down your computer when it's not in use, over time, these small efforts can save you big energy dollars.

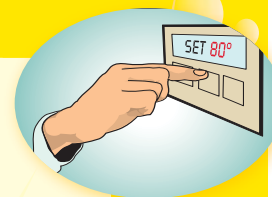

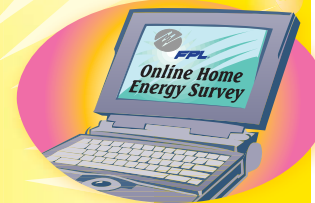
2. Use Efficient Lighting
